PLANS, FUTURE, HOPF

"For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not

for evil, to give you a future and a hope." Jeremiah 29:11 ESV

Jeremiah wrote these words about God's steadfast love and faithfulness as God's people were in exile in Babylon. As a prophet, Jeremiah was called to speak both the full truth of the challenges his people would face, but also the promise that God would never cease His persistent care for His people. These were words of true hope in the midst of challenge, struggle, and grief.

As God's people today, gathered together as Faith Lutheran Church, our situation is very different from Jeremiah and God's people in exile. However, God's promise of plans, future, and hope stand true. Ultimately, that plan, future, and hope is about our salvation in Christ – God delivering us from our exile of sin and death and rescuing us once and for all by bringing us home to Himself forever. And, in the meantime, God gives us opportunities, just as He did for His people in Babylon, to work together and to minister both to one another and to the community into which He has placed us.

On October 13, please join us as we gather at 9:30AM for a combined worship service followed by a luncheon and an exciting "Visioning Workshop" as we reflect on God's Mission among us and our community. We will look together at the future and hope that God has in store for us both ultimately and while on His Mission together as a congregation. We will begin to plan together for where God is leading us in mission.

PASTOR'S MESSAGE CONTINUES...

This is an exciting time for us as we explore God's call to action through His Gospel. He calls us as He called Jeremiah to carry His truth of Law and Gospel to our community through our ministry that we call Faith Lutheran Church. Rev. Don Schaefer and Director of Christian Outreach (DCO) Tina Jasion will lead us through this process of discovery as we seek God's guidance and discernment for our ministry together.

Right now, I would ask you to pray. Pray for our church leadership — me, our council, and our elders. Pray for our community, especially those who don't yet realize the future and hope that God has promised and planned for them in Christ. Sometimes I ask myself if this may have been Gods way to slow me down and allow me to become more active in His work... a kind of stop and smell the roses and give thanks to God for the roses in the first place! I have always been told that God never gives us more than we can handle and always thought that was the way it was. But now I have come to believe that it is more like, God never gives us more than "HE" can handle! I have come to understand that difficult times and things are meant to either teach us a lesson or show us the way that God wants us to go and do His work.

So, with that and with the time that God has blessed me with... I will try to be a better disciple for Him in any little way I can and to try to help all that I encounter. At the same time, I wish to thank everyone who has prayed for my healing and I want to thank you all for the support that you have extended to both Betty Ann and I through this. I have learned even more and do now understand that... "God is in control!"


WOODEN PLATFORM CROSS
